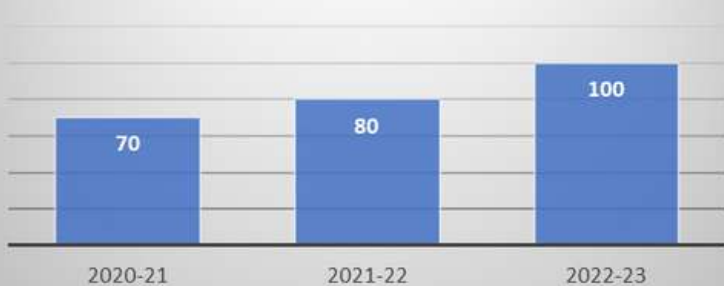

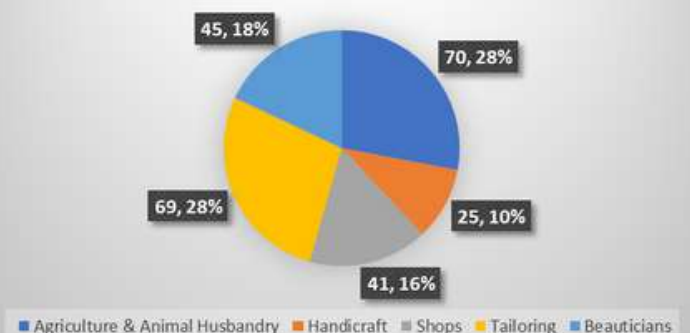

Categorization of Women Entrepreneurs - Impact Board 2022-23



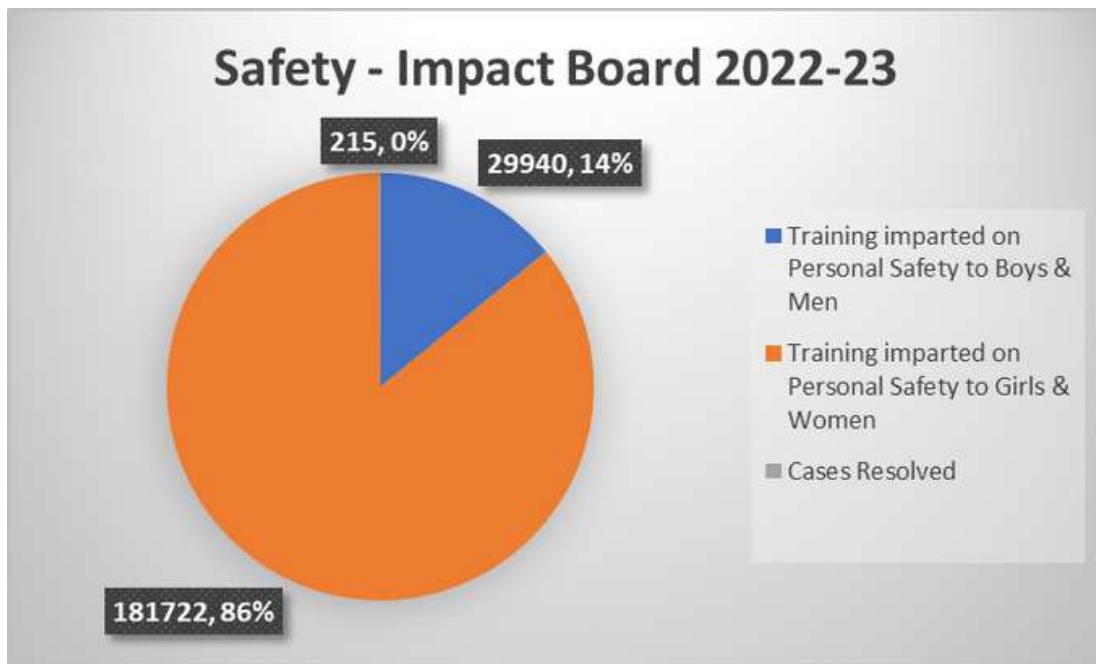

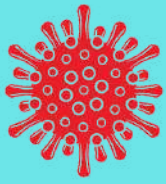

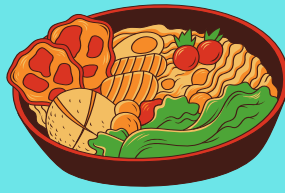

Food becoming an essential people were effected with hunger during lockdown loosing their hope. Under Food Steps initiative cooled meal was served to deprived communities and children

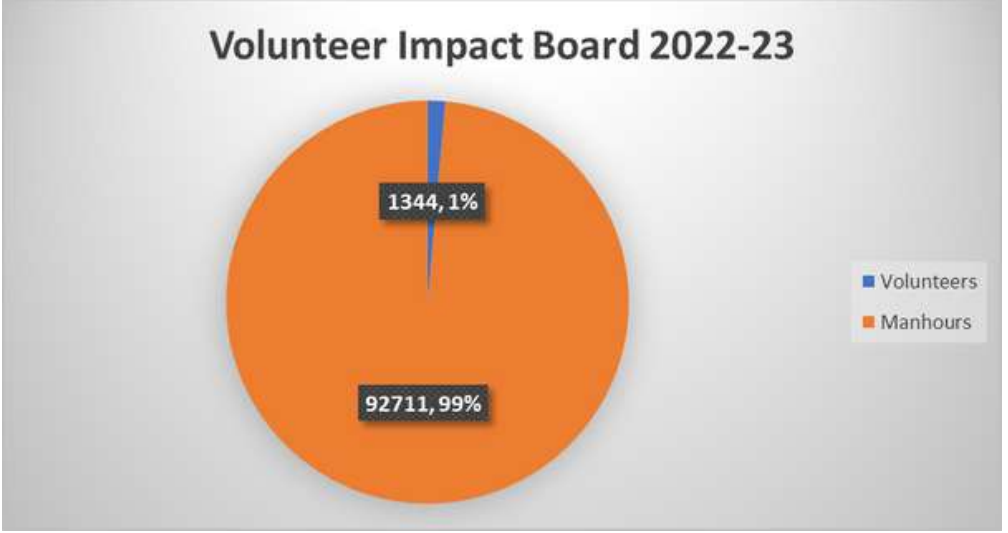

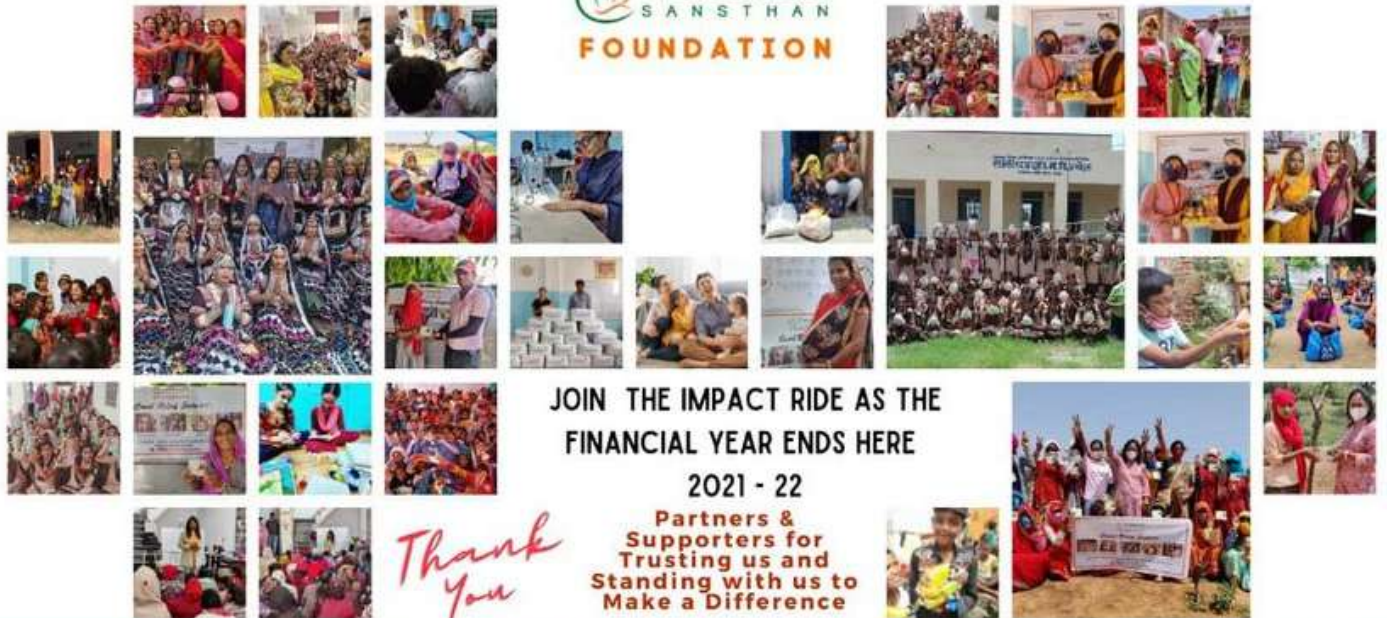
